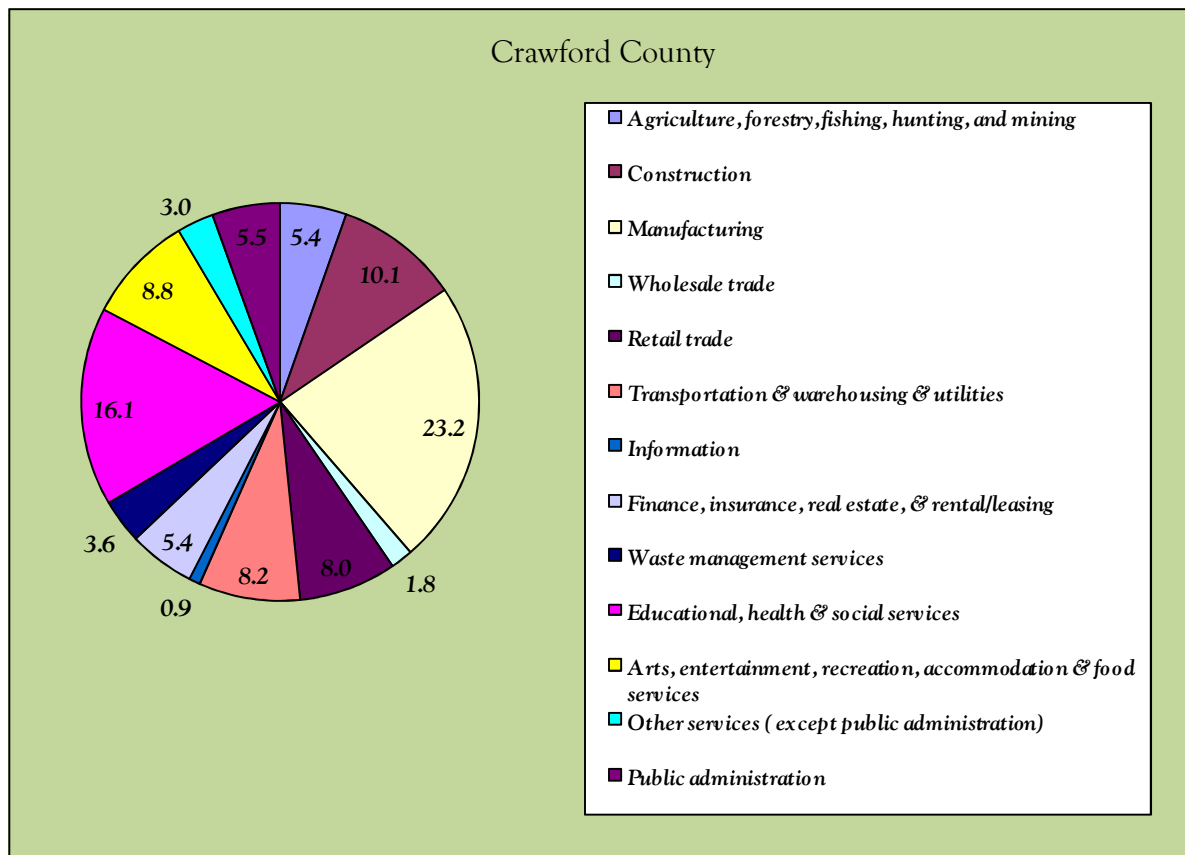

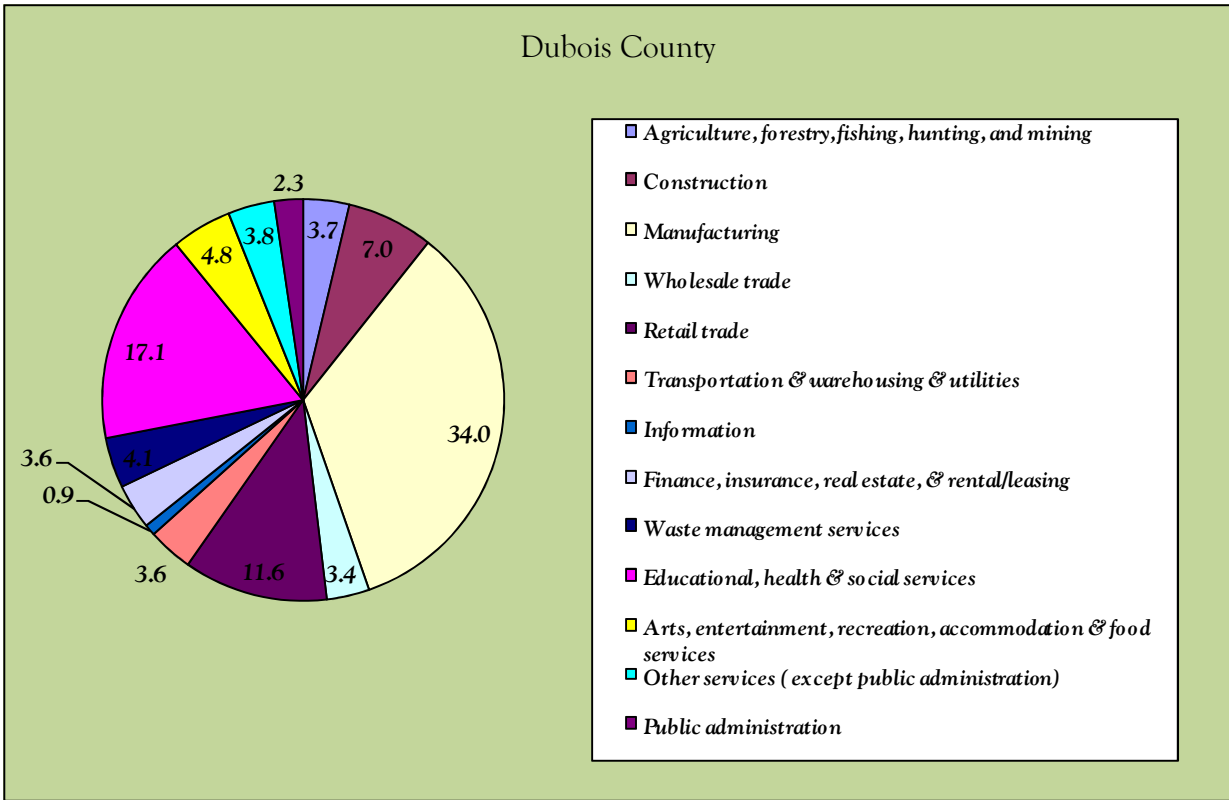

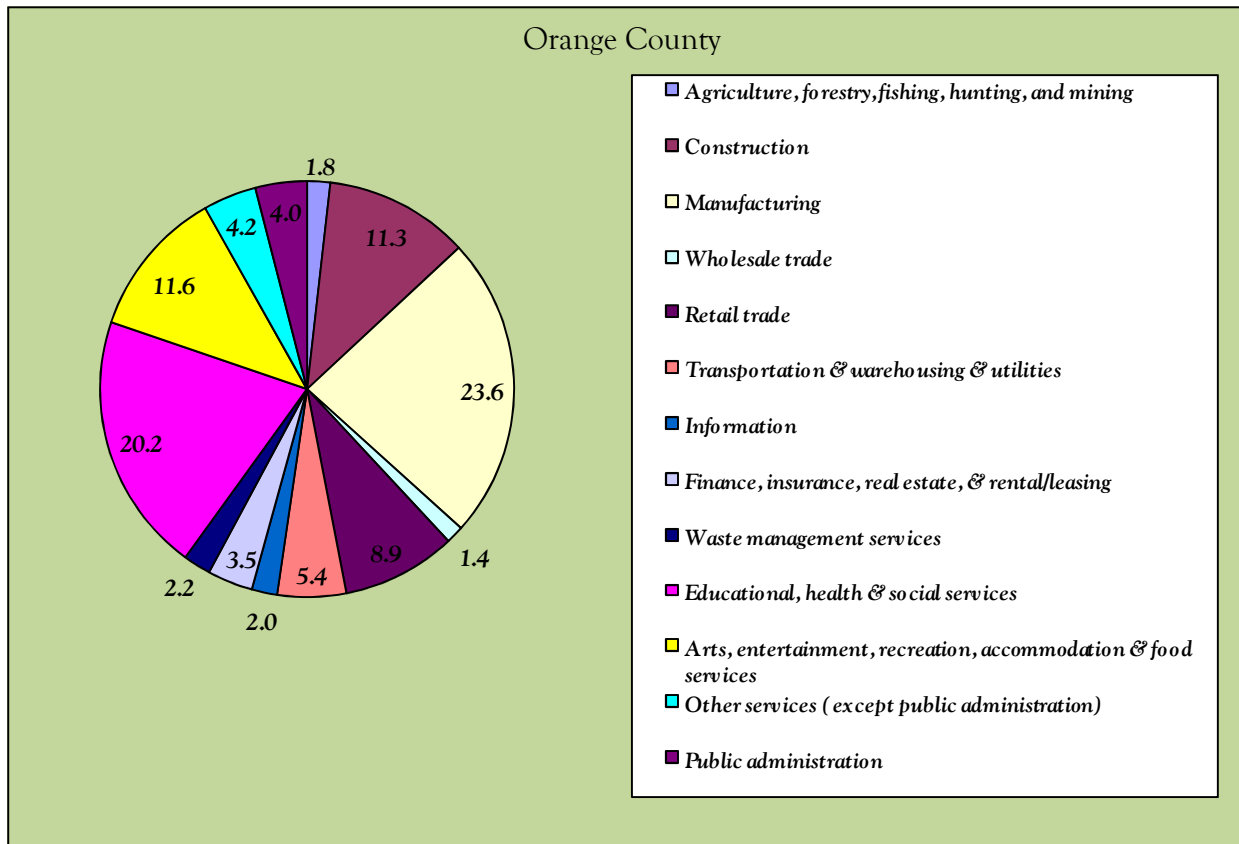

Percent of Industrial Employment by County

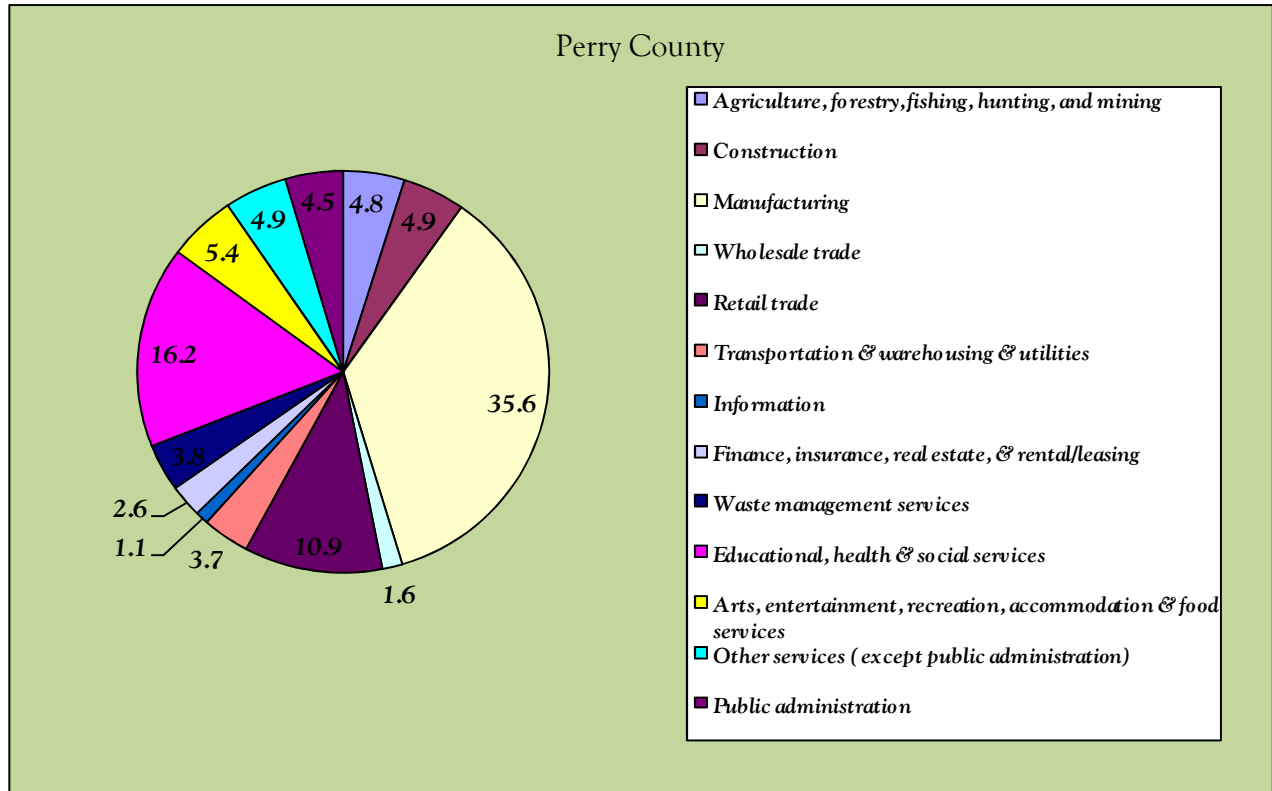

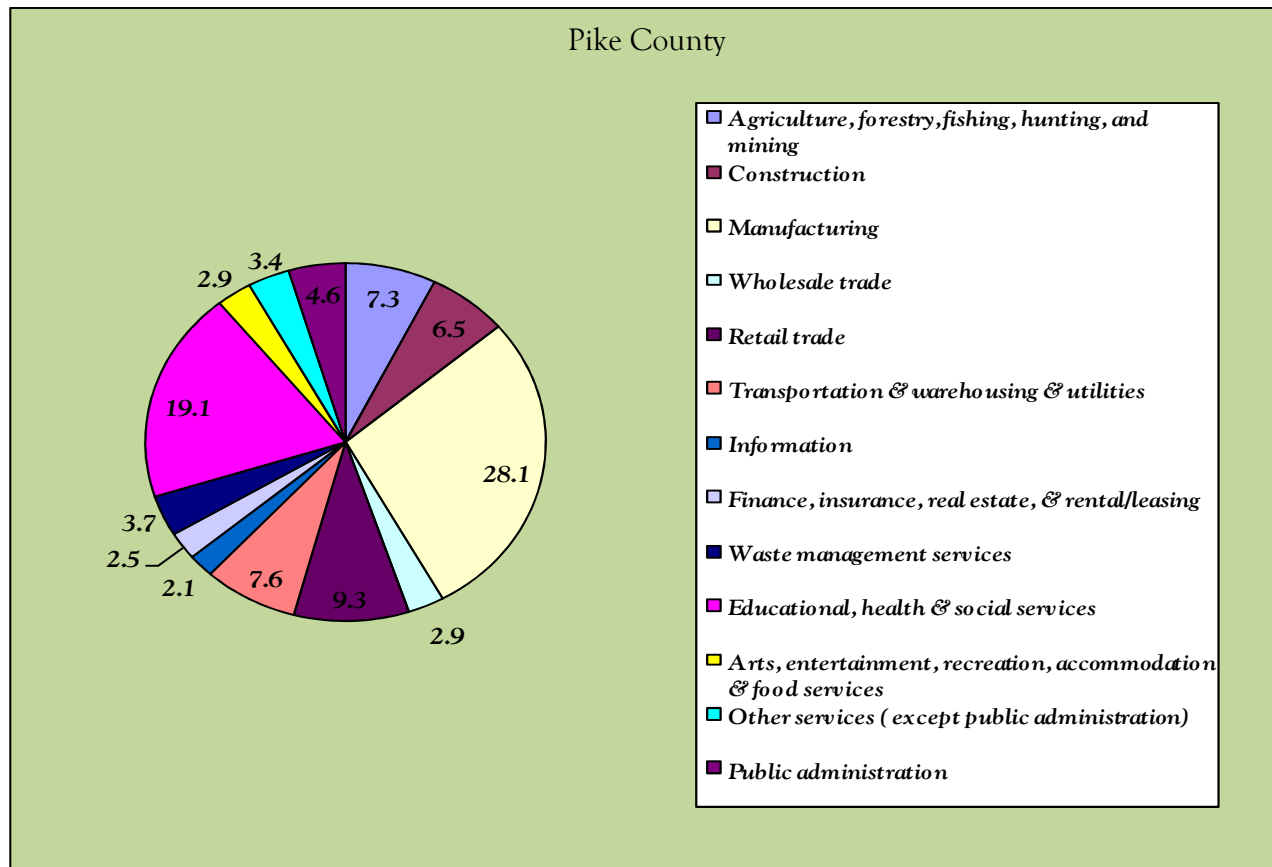

Percent of Industrial Employment by County

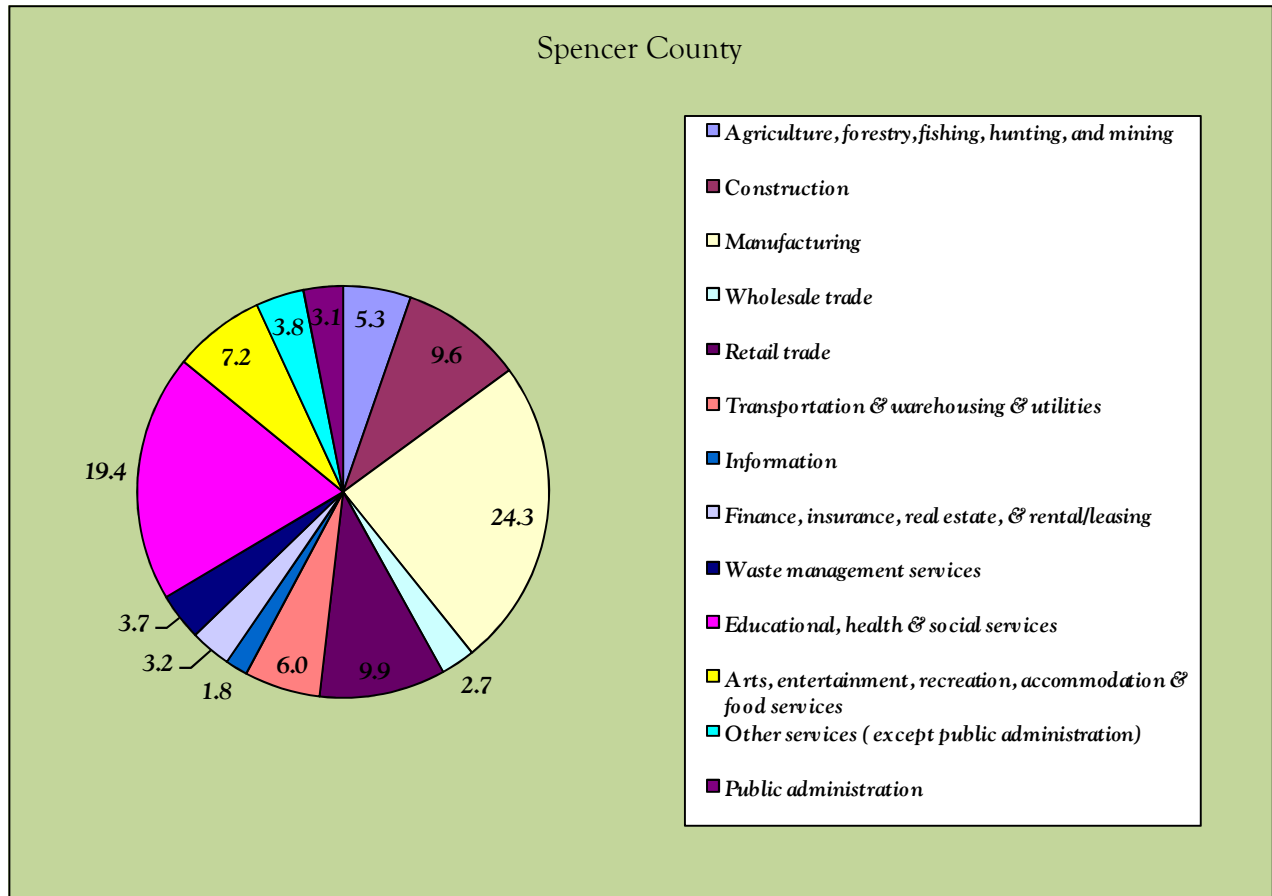
