5.06.010 Dogs running at large prohibited. It is unlawful for any person owning or harboring any dog or dogs to permit the same to run at large or stray upon the streets or alleys of the town or upon the premises of any other person. (Ordinance unnumbered, March 1, 1943)

5.06.020 Enforcement and penalties. The Marshal is ordered and directed to enforce this Chapter in the following manner: Any dog found by him running at large or straying upon said streets, alleys or premises or any other person in said town shall be taken up by said Marshal and impounded by him for a period of three days. Notice shall be given to the owner, if known, if the owner or any person in his behalf shall pay to the Marshal the sum of one dollar for each dog impounded, within said time, then said dog or dogs shall be released to the person paying said penalty. At the end of three days from the time of the taking up of said dog or dogs, if no person has paid said penalty, then any dog or dogs so impounded shall be killed and buried by the Marshal, for which services he shall receive and collect from the town the sum of one dollar and fifty cents for each dog so killed and buried. Any person, other than the Marshal may take up any stray dog and deliver same to the Marshal for impounding. (Ordinance unnumbered, March 1, 1943)
