DOGS

7.02.010 Dogs to remain on owners premises. Be it ordained by the Town of Leavenworth, County of Crawford, State of Indiana that owners of dogs are required to keep them on their own premises unless the owner is in attendance with the dog or dogs and have complete control of them. (Ord. 2-1980, Art. 1, Mar. 4, 1980) (Ord. 1, S1, Feb. 19, 1925)

7.02.020 Fine for dog running at large. The owner permitting a dog to run at large in violation of this Ordinance will be fined \$75.00 each day the dog is in violation. (Ord. 2013-4, Mar. 11, 2013) (Ord. 2012-2, no date, 2012) (Ord. 10, Oct. 6, 1980) (Ord. 2-1980, Art. 2, Mar. 4, 1980) (Ord. 1, S2, Feb. 19, 1925)

7.02.030 Notification to owner. When a dog is known to be running at large, the Town Marshal is hereby instructed to contact the owner of that dog and notify him or her of this Ordinance. One notification is sufficient for all future violations. The owner must comply with Section 7.02.010 above within 24 hours or be subject to the fine imposed by Section 7.02.020. If the owner refuses to pay the imposed fine within 48 hours, the Marshal is instructed to dispose of the dog. (Ord. 2-1980, Art. 3, Mar. 4, 1980) (Ord. 1, S3, Feb. 19, 1925)

7.02.040 Unknown owner. In event the owner of a dog is not known or cannot be contacted, the Marshal is instructed to dispose of the dog the second day it is found at large. (Ord. 2-1980, Art. 4, Mar. 4, 1980) (Ord. 1, S5, Feb. 19, 1925)

7.02.050 Disposal of dogs. The Marshal, when disposing of dogs, is instructed to catch them and make final disposition outside the Town limits of Leavenworth. Shooting of dogs within the Town limits will only be done when all efforts to catch the dogs have failed or the dogs are too vicious to approach. (Ord. 2-1980, Art. 5, Mar. 4, 1980)

7.02.060 Fines payable to Town. All fines imposed by provisions of this Ordinance are to be paid to the Town Clerk-Treasurer payable to the credit of the General Fund of this Town. (Ord. 2-1980, Art. 6, Mar. 4, 1980) (Ord. 1, S6, Feb. 19, 1925)

7.02.070 Identification tags. To avoid a possible mistake in establishing the identity and ownership of dogs, it is suggested dog owners require their dogs to wear collars with the owner's identification attached. (Ord. 2-1980, Mar. 4, 1980)

Chapter 7.04

GRAZING

Sections:

7.04.010 Grazing along streets and alleys

7.04.020 Penalty for violation

7.04.010 Grazing along streets and alleys. Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Leavenworth, State of Indiana, that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to tether any cow, horses, mule or any other stock upon or along any street alley or other highway within the corporate limits of said Town by tying to stakes, trees or in any other manner for the purpose of grazing.

Provided, however, that stock may be allowed to graze upon said streets or highways if accompanied by the owner or an attendant and led by halter or rope but in no case shall stock be allowed run loose upon said streets.

Provided, further, that if property owners abutting said streets or highways object to grazing in front of their premises it shall be unlawful to do so. (Ord. 4, S1, June 24, 1920)

7.04.020 Penalty for violation. Any person or persons violating this Ordinance shall be fined in any sum not less than one nor more than Five Dollars for each separate offense. (Ord. 4, S2, June 24, 1920)

7.10.010 Hog pen construction requirements. Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the town of Leavenworth, in the County of Crawford, State of Indiana, that every person, partnership, firm or corporation, now keeping, or who shall hereafter keep a pig or pigs, a hog or hogs, in pens, within the corporate limits of the said town of Leavenworth, shall keep same in pens constructed with tight floors, which floor shall not be less than eighteen inches above the ground. Such pens shall be built so that the sun can shine in, and on them during the day. (Ord. 5, S1, June 19, 1924)

7.10.020 Reconstruction to meet requirements of Section 7.10.010. All owners or lessors of realty situated within the corporate limits of the town of Leavenworth, who are now keeping a pig or pigs, a hog or hogs, in pens therein, the construction of which is not in accord with the requirements of the ordinance, shall within ten days after the passage of the same re-model or re-construct said pens in accordance with the specifications of Section 7.10.010 of this Ordinance. (Ord. 5, S2, June 19, 1924)

7.10.030 Cleaning hog pens. Every owner or lessor of realty situated within the corporate limits of the town of Leavenworth, upon which realty is situated a hog pen shall thoroughly clean and disinfect odors. Cleanings from said pens shall be covered with lime and buried, or otherwise destroyed of in such manner as to prevent their emitting foul and offensive odors. (Ord. 5, S3, June 19, 1924)

7.10.040 Odors from hog pens. Hog pens that give out foul and offensive odors are hereby declared to be nuisances. (Ord. 5, S4, June 19, 1924)

7.10.050 Right to inspection/Failure to abate nuisance. It shall be the duty of the Town Marshal and his deputies to inspect any and all pens, they shall have full power and authority to enter into or upon any lot, premises or grounds for the purpose of making such inspections. If any hog pen emitting foul and offensive odors are found thereon, it shall be the duty of the Marshal to notify the person or persons offending to abate the said nuisances. Shall such person or persons fail or refuse to abate the said nuisance within ten days after notice is given, it shall be the duty of the Town Marshal, upon order of the town trustees, to abate or cause to be abated said nuisance, keeping an accurate account of the expenses incurred in so doing, which expenses shall be paid out of the town treasury upon

the sworn, itemized statement of the Town Marshal, and said expenses, no was found and so abated, and shall be collected as other taxes are collected and turned into the town treasury. (Ord. 5, S5, June 19, 1924)

7.10.060 Penalty for violation. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) for a single offense; and each days violation shall constitute a separate offense. (Ord. 5, S6, June 19, 1924)
