Chapter 7.03

DOGS

Sections:

7.03.010 Stray dogs. It is an offense for an owner to allow his/her dog or dogs to stray beyond his/her premises, unless said dog or dogs are under the reasonable control of some person. (Ord. 009-97, June 9, 1997)

7.03.020 Reasonable control defined. Reasonable control includes but is not limited to having said dog or dogs on a leash. (Ord. 009-97, June 9, 1997)

7.03.030 Fine for violation. An owner who is cited for violation of this chapter shall be subject to a fine of Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) thereof, to be recovered according to law. (Ord. 2010-002, S7.03.030, (Ord. 009-97, June 9, 1997)

7.03.040 Stray and abandoned animal shelter fund. There is established a stray and abandoned animal shelter fund. All monies collected under this chapter shall be deposited into said fund with said funds to be applied to the administrative costs and costs of animal care relative to the enforcement of this chapter. (Ord. 2010-002, S7.03.040 Feb. 8, 2010).

Chapter 7.04

RUNNING AT LARGE

7.04.010 Animals running at large. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, corporation or company, owning, harboring, or having in their possession any cow, bull, calf, sow, boar, barrow, pig, mule, jack, jenny, mare, stallion, colt, horse, sheep, goat or other animal to permit the same to run at large upon the streets, alleys, or commons, within the corporate limits of the incorporated Town of Milltown. (Ord. 8, S1, July 6, 1903) (Ord. 1, S1, No date)

7.04.020 Penalty for violation. An owner who is cited for violation of this chapter shall be subject to a fine of Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) thereof, to be recovered according to law. (Ord. 2010-001, S7.04.020, Feb. 8, 2010) (Ord. 8, S2, July 6, 1903) (Ord. 1, S2, No date)

7.04.030 Stray and abandoned animal shelter fund. There is established a stray and abandoned animal shelter fund. All monies collected under this chapter shall be deposited into said fund with said funds to be applied to the administrative costs and costs of animal care relative to the enforcement of this chapter. (Ord. 2010-002, S7.04.030 Feb. 8, 2010).

Chapter 7.05

STRAY AND ABANDONED ANIMAL SHELTER FUND

7.05.010 Establishment. There is hereby established a Stray and Abandoned Animal Shelter Fund beginning March 1, 2010. (Ord. 2010-001, S1, Feb. 8, 2010)

7.05.020 Non-reverting fund. The Stray and Abandoned Animal Shelter Fund is a non-reverting fund. (Ord. 2010-001, S2, Feb. 8, 2010)

7.05.030 Purpose. The purpose of the Stray and Abandoned Animal Shelter Fund is to be used to defray general administrative and operating expenses of the Town of Milltown, relative to the enforcement of Chapter 7.03 and 7.04 of the Municipal Code and all other purposes that may be allowed by law. (Ord. 2010-001, S3, Feb. 8, 2010)

7.05.040 Funding. The Town of Milltown Stray and Abandoned Animal Shelter Fund shall be funded solely from the collection of fines for violation of Chapter 7.03 and 7.04 of the Municipal Code. (Ord. 2010-001, S4, Feb. 8, 2010)

Chapter 7.12

HITCHING OR TYING ANIMALS

Sections:

- 7.12.020 **Penalty for violation**

7.12.010 Places where hitching animals is prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons within the corporate limits of said town, to hitch, or tie any horse, or horses, or other animal, or animals, to any fence, shade tree, house, barn, or building upon any street or alley within the corporate limits of town. (Ord. No. 1, pt. S1, July 6, 1903)

7.12.020 Penalty for violation. Any person or persons, who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance (chapter) herein expressed, upon conviction thereof, shall be liable for a forfeiture to said Town of Milltown a fine, penalty and forfeiture, for each and every offense committed, in the sum of \$1.00 to be recovered according to law. (Ord. No. 1, pt. S2, July 6, 1903)
