Chapter 5.02

Keeping of Animals

5.02.010 Keeping of animals within town. It shall be unlawful to keep, harbor and pasture horses, mules, cattle, sheep, swine or goats within the corporate limits of the Town of West Baden Springs, Indiana. (Ordinance 1964-3, S1, May 20, 1964)

5.20.020 Penalties for violation. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined in the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars. (Ord. 1964-3, S2, May 20, 1964)

5.02.030 Repeal of previous ordinances. Any and all ordinances heretofore adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of West Baden Springs which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. (Ord. 1964-3, S3, May 20, 1964)

5.03.010 Definitions. As used in this ordinance the following terms mean:

- A. Owner. Any person, partnership or corporation owning, keeping or harboring any animal.
- B. Kenel. Any person, partnership or corporation engaged in the business of breeding, buying, selling or boarding dogs or other animals.
- C. Veterinary Hospital. Any establishment maintained and operated by a licensed veterinarian for the diagnosis and treatment of diseases and injuries of animals.
- D. Animal. Any living creature, domestic or wild. (Ord. 88-2, S1, 1988)

5.03.020 Cruelty. No person shall cruelly treat any animal in the town in any way; any person who inhumanely beats, underfeeds, overloads, or abandons any animal shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this section. (Ord. 88-2, S2-1, 1988)

5.03.030 Animals running at large. It shall be unlawful to permit any animal of any kind to run at large within the Town. Any animal found running loose on the streets, sidewalks or other public property within the Town of West Baden Springs shall be taken the nearest animal pound and held for no less than three (3) days, after which the animal may be sold or destroyed.

The owner of any animal found running at large shall be issued a citation to appear in Court, and upon conviction may be assessed a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00), which said fine shall be paid to the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of West Baden Springs to be placed in a fund to defray expense incurred by the Town for the maintenance of impounded animals to defray the expenses of enforcing this ordinance. 5.03.040 Noises. It shall be unlawful for any person to own, keep, or harbor any animal, which, by frequent or habitual howling, yelping, barking or other noise, shall cause annoyance or disturbance to any family, other than that of the owner, or

neighborhood. (Ord. 88-2, S2-3, 1988)

5.03.050 Unlawful ownership. It shall be unlawful to entice any animal away from the premises of the person owning, keeping or harboring the same with the intent of depriving any such owner, keeper or person harboring such animal of the possession thereof. (Ord. 88-2, S2-4, 1988)

5.03.060 Penalty. Any person convicted of a violation of any provision of this ordinance, where a penalty is not otherwise provided, shall be fined in any sum not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), except than on a second or subsequent offense the fine shall be not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) (Ord. 88-2, S3, 1988)
