Chapter 4.08

PEDDLERS

4.08.010 License required. Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Winslow, Indiana, that it shall hereafter be unlawful for any person not a resident of Pike County, Indiana, to sell upon the public streets of the Town of Winslow, Indiana, fruits, groceries, potatoes, meats and other articles without first obtaining a permit so to do from said town and paying a license therefore. (Ord. unnumbered, S1, May 15, 1922) (Ord. 59, Sept. 7, 1908)

4.08.020 License fee. That any person desiring to sell goods, groceries, fruits, potatoes, meats or other articles upon the public streets of the Town of Winslow shall pay therefore a license fee of \$5 per day for such privilege, such fee to be paid to the clerk of said town. (Ord. unnumbered, S2, May 15, 1922) (Ord. 59, Sept. 7, 1908)

4.08.030 Penalty for violation. Any person or persons violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction, pay a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$25.00 for each day he shall be offend. (Ord. unnumbered, S3, May 15, 1922) (Ord. 59, Sept. 7, 1908)

4.08.040 Enforcement. It is hereby made the duty of the Town Marshal to enforce the provisions of this ordinance. (Ord. unnumbered, S4, May 15, 1922)

Chapter 4.12

SHOWS, EXHIBITIONS, CARNIVALS AND OTHER FORMS OF AMUSEMENT

4.12.010 License required. Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the incorporated Town of Winslow, Pike County, Indiana, that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firms, company or corporation, either by himself or themselves, servants, agents or employees, to operate, conduct, establish, maintain or exhibit any menagerie, circus, carnival, moving picture show, or other show, exhibition or performance for gain or profit; or to operate, conduct, establish or maintain any merry-go-round or Ferris wheel, within the corporate limits of the said Town of Winslow, Pike County, Indiana, without first procuring a license so to do from said town as provided in Sections 4.12.020 and 4.12.040 of this chapter. (Ord. unnumbered, S1, May 7, 1928)

4.12.020 License fee. Be it further ordained by said Board of Trustees that the fees for license as provided in Section 4.12.010 of this chapter shall be as follows:

For tent shows of any kind or troops performing in any building, \$10.00 per day or \$50.00 per week; for operating, conducting, or maintaining any street carnival, \$25.00 per day. For operating or conducting or maintaining and merry-go-round or ferris wheel shall be \$10.00 per day; for operating or conducting or maintaining any moving picture show shall pay \$25.00 per year. (Ord. unnumbered, S2, May 7, 1928)

4.12.030 Exemptions from these provisions. This ordinance (chapter) shall not apply to chautauquas, lyceums, exhibitions of live stock or farm products, nor to shows, exhibitions or performances given for charitable purposes, the proceeds of which is to be used in said town nor to shows, exhibitions, performances given for the benefits of any of the churches of said town. (Ord. unnumbered, S3, May 7, 1928)

4.12.040 Issuance of license. It shall be the duty of the Clerk-Treasurer of said town to issue a license to any person, persons, firm, company or corporation applying therefor, on payment of the license fee provided in Section 4.12.020 of this chapter with a fee of fifty cents to the Clerk-Treasurer issuing said license. (Ord. unnumbered, S4, May 7, 1928)

4.12.050 Penalty for violation. Any person, persons, firm, company or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance (chapter) shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay to the said Town of Winslow, a sum not exceeding fifteen dollars for each and every day such business requiring a license is carried on in violation of this ordinance

(chapter) when the license fees does not exceed fifteen dollars per day as provided in this ordinance (chapter); and any person, persons, firm, company or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance (chapter) shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay to the said Town of Winslow, a sum not exceeding the license fee provided in this ordinance for each and every day such business requiring a license is carried on in violation of this ordinance where the license fee exceeds fifteen dollars per day as provided in this ordinance to which shall be added the sum of five dollars attorney fee for the town attorney for each and every case so prosecuted by the town attorney under this ordinance to be collected in case of misdemeanor. Chapter 4.16

SKATING RINKS / BOWLING ALLEYS

4.16.010 License required to operate any skating rink or bowling alley. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firms, company or corporations, either by himself or themselves, servants, agents or employees, to operate, conduct, establish or maintain any skating rink or bowling alley within the corporate limits of the Town of Winslow, Indiana, without procuring a license so to do from said town as provided in Section 4.16.020 and 4.16.030 of this chapter. (Ord. unnumbered, S1, Dec. 1, 1924)

4.16.020 License fees. Be it further ordained by said Board of Trustees that the fees for license as provided in Section 4.16.010 of this chapter shall be as follows: For a skating rink conducted in the Community Building situate in such town the license fee shall be fifteen (\$15.00) dollars per year; for any portable skating rink the fee shall be five (\$5.00) dollars per day; for any bowling alley in any building in said town the license fee shall be five (\$5.00) dollars per year. (Ord. unnumbered, S2, Dec. 1, 1924)

4.16.030 Issuance of license. It shall be the duty of the Clerk-Treasurer of said town to issue a license to any person, firm, company or corporation, applying therefor, on payment of the license fee provided in Section 4.16.020 of this chapter with a fee of fifty (50¢) cents to the Clerk-Treasurer issuing said license. (Ord. unnumbered, S3, Dec. 1, 1924)

4.16.040 Penalty for violation. Any person, persons, firm, company or corporation who shall have violated any of the provisions of this ordinances (chapter) shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay to the said Town of Winslow, a sum not exceeding five (\$5.00) dollars for each and every day such business requiring a license is carried on in violation of this ordinance, (chapter) to which shall be added the sum of (\$5.00) attorney fee for each and every case so prosecuted by the town attorney under this ordinance (chapter), to be collected as other fines and costs are collected in case of misdemeanor. (Ord. unnumbered, S4, Dec. 1, 1924)

Chapter 4.18

POOL ROOMS, BILLIARD AND RHUM TABLES

4.18.010 License required. Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Winslow, Indiana, that it shall be unlawful for any person, persons or employees himself or themselves to maintain or operate any pool hall, billiard parlor, pool tables or rhum tables within the corporate limits of the Town of Winslow, Indiana without first procuring a license to do so from said town as provided in section 4.18.020 and 4.18.030 of this chapter. (Ord. unnumbered, S1, Jan. 4, 1932)

4.18.020 License fee. Be it further ordained by said Board that the fee for license shall be twenty five (\$25.00) per annum for the first pool table and fifteen (\$15.00) dollars for the second table and ten (\$10.00) dollars per annum for each additional table and fifteen (\$15.00) dollars per annum for the rhum table and ten (\$10.00) dollars per annum for each additional rhum table operated in the Town of Winslow, Pike County, Indiana. (Ord. unnumbered, S2, Jan. 4, 1932)

4.18.030 Issuance of license. It shall be the duty of the Clerk-Treasurer of said town, to issue a license to any person, persons or corporation applying therefor upon payment of fees provided in section 4.18.020 of this chapter, with a fee of fifty (50¢) cents to the Clerk-Treasurer issuing such license. (Ord. unnumbered, S3, Jan. 4, 1932)

4.18.040 Closing time / Placement of rhum or card tables. It is further ordained by said Board that places having pool tables and rhum tables shall close promptly at eleven o'clock of each evening and that on failure to do so that upon conviction of such failure may have his license revoked and the town shall retain the fees paid. Operators of rhum tables or card tables shall be required to place such tables in conspicuous places so that they may be easily observed by the public. (Ord. unnumbered, S4, Jan. 4, 1932)

4.18.050 Penalty for violation. Any person, persons or corporation who shall violate any provision of this ordinance (chapter) shall upon conviction thereof forfeit and pay to said Town a sum not exceeding five (\$5.00) dollars for each and every day such business requiring a license is carried on in violation of this ordinance (chapter), to which shall be added the sum of five (\$5.00) dollars attorney fees for each and every case prosecuted under this ordinance (chapter), to be collected as other fines and costs are collected in case of misdemeanor. (Ord. unnumbered, S5, Jan. 4, 1932)
